Thank you for purchasing a Keith Hamilton Bluestone Fire product.

The information below provides a guideline for the proper use of the product, as well as maintenance tips, to ensure the long life of this product.

BLUESTONE PIZZA OVENS

- Please ensure that you follow the instructions as per the Installation and Operating Information provided in this package.

If you have misplaced the Installation and Operating Information, you can access a copy on our website www.keithhamilton.co.za.

- Please **don't** throw logs into the pizza oven, as this may cause the interior shell to crack. We recommend that you purchase a log-lifter to place logs in the pizza oven.

We recommend that you use eco fire starters and not paraffin fire starters in the pizza oven. Please avoid the use of fire accelerants that will cause a rapid thermal expansion and may cause the shell to crack.

- Bluestone Pizza Ovens are supplied with a mild steel metal band that contains the cooking surface bricks. The metal has been treated to protect against rust but, over time, rust may occur. Please treat (rust) as follows to maintain appearance and extend longevity of the metal band:
 - o Use a wire brush/sandpaper to remove rust
 - o Wipe dust away with a cloth
 - o Apply anti-rust paint to the area with a paint brush
 - o Apply a light coat of anti-rust paint to the entire metal band to revive the appearance of the metal
- When cool, pizza ovens can be cleaned with soap and water, and a soft brush.
- Bluestone Pizza Ovens are designed to handle severe heat. Small cracks may form during the lifespan of the pizza oven due to tension release in the normal heating and cooling process. The performance and lifespan of the pizza oven will not be compromised by these small cracks.
